

Washington Park Lawn Bowling Club COVID – 19 Playing Guidelines, June 7, 2020

Overview:

- Follow the Center for Disease Control & Prevention guidelines <u>http://www.cdc.gov</u>
- All relevant Denver Parks & Recreation Rules & Regulations must be followed.
- All state and city Covid -19 guidelines must be followed and this document will be updated accordingly.
- The club is dedicated to protecting the health and safety of both the public and its members. In order to remain open, all members, guests, and any spectators inside the fence area must obey the following guidelines designed for everyone's protection.
- If you feel sick or are awaiting test results, stay home. If you have been exposed to someone with Covid, you should self- quarantine for 14 days before playing.
- Everyone entering the fenced area will be required to read this document and fill out a tracing form with their name and contact information.

Guidelines for inside the fenced area:

- Hands must be sanitized before and after play. Bring your own sanitizer, mask, wipes, gloves etc.
- Social distancing of at least 6 feet from everyone is required at all times during play, except for members of the same household.
- All persons must be prepared to wear a face mask, and everyone is encouraged to wear them. If you are alone or with another household member it is not required.
- No more than 25 people are allowed inside this area at any time.
- A maximum of 4 players are allowed in a game.
- No shaking hands or physical contact between players, except for members of the same household.
- Equipment is not to be shared. Within each game a player should be assigned responsibility to handle certain equipment and sanitize it.
- If you touch another player's equipment, it must be sanitized before resuming play.
- Only one member at a time is permitted in the equipment shed.

Adhering to the above guidelines will provide a safer environment for all concerned. We appreciate everyone's cooperation.
