The club is dedicated to protecting the health and safety of both the public and its members. In order to remain open during the pandemic, all members, guests, and any spectators inside the fence area must obey the following guidelines, which are designed for everyone's protection.

Overview:

- Follow the Center for Disease Control & Prevention and State of Colorado guidelines.
- All relevant Denver Parks and Recreation rules and regulations must be followed.
- All state and city COVID-19 guidelines must be followed and this document will be updated accordingly.
- If you feel sick or are awaiting test results, stay home. If you have been exposed to someone with COVID, you should self-quarantine for 14 days before playing.
- Everyone entering the fenced area will be required to read this document and fill out a tracing form with their name and contact information.

Guidelines for inside the fenced area:

- Hands and equipment must be sanitized before and after play. The club will provide sanitizer and wipes. However, it is a good idea to bring your own safety supplies as well.
- Social distancing of at least 6 feet from everyone is required at all times during play, except for members of the same household.
- All persons are strongly encouraged to wear a face mask at all times inside the fenced area of the green. If you are alone or with another household member, a mask is not required. Bring your own mask.
- A maximum of 4 players are allowed in a game.
- No shaking hands or physical contact between players, except for members of the same household.
- Equipment is not to be shared. Within each game a player should be assigned responsibility to handle certain equipment and sanitize it.
- If you touch another player's equipment, it must be sanitized before resuming play.
- Only one member at a time is permitted in the equipment shed.

Adhering to the above guidelines will provide a safer environment for all concerned. We appreciate everyone's cooperation.
